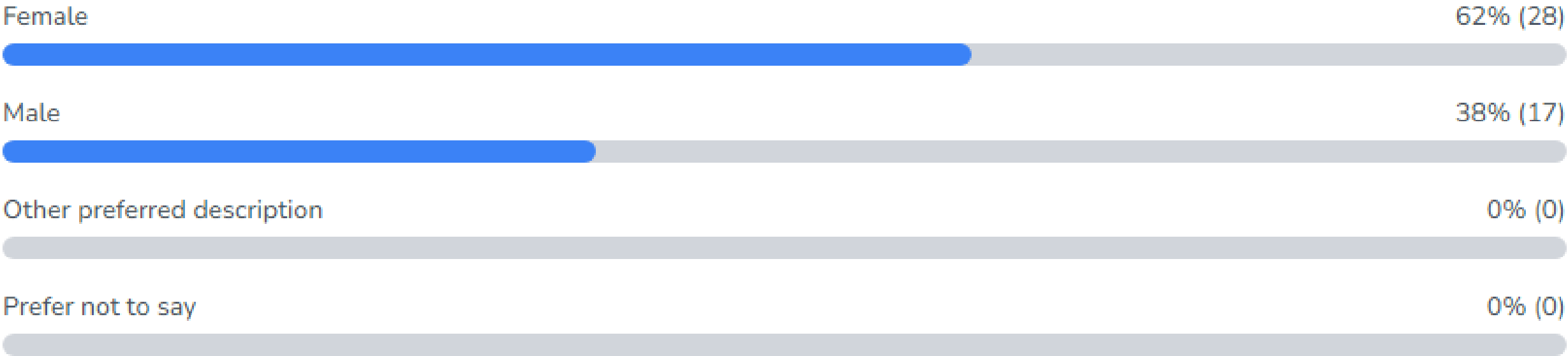

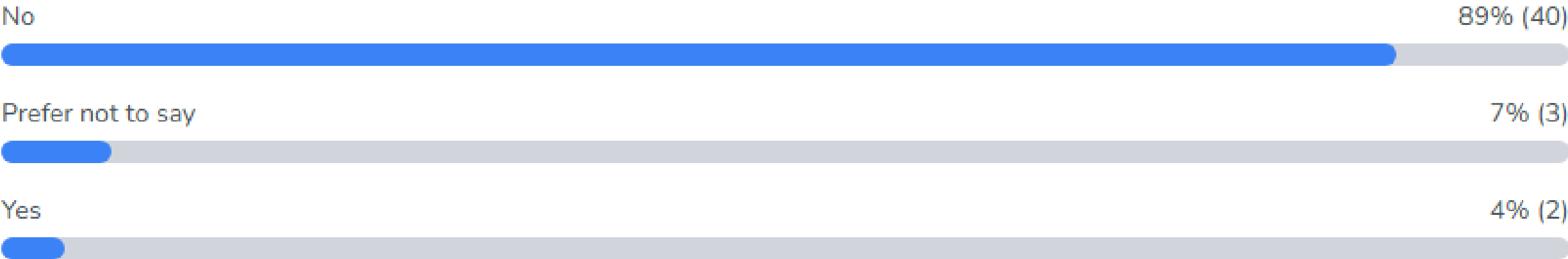


Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?



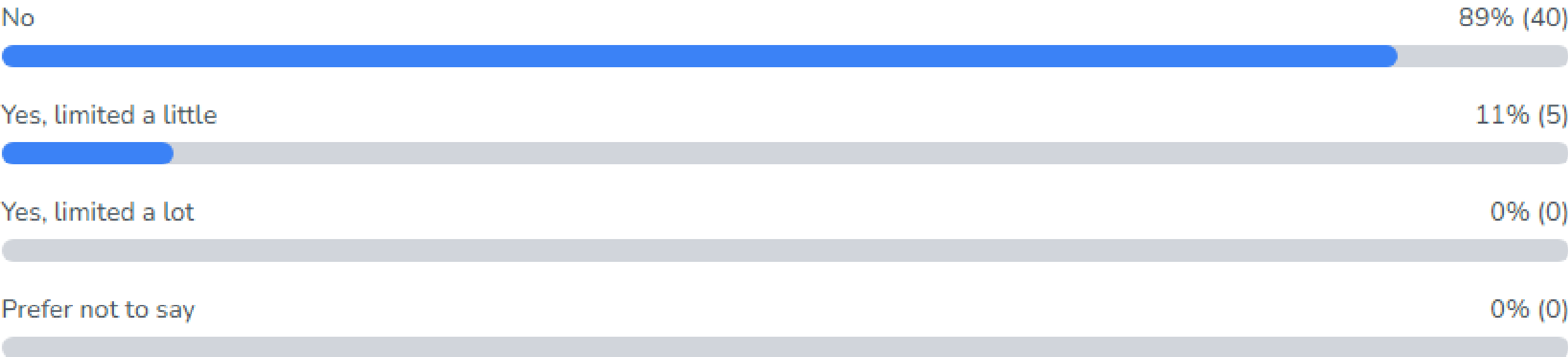
# Disability

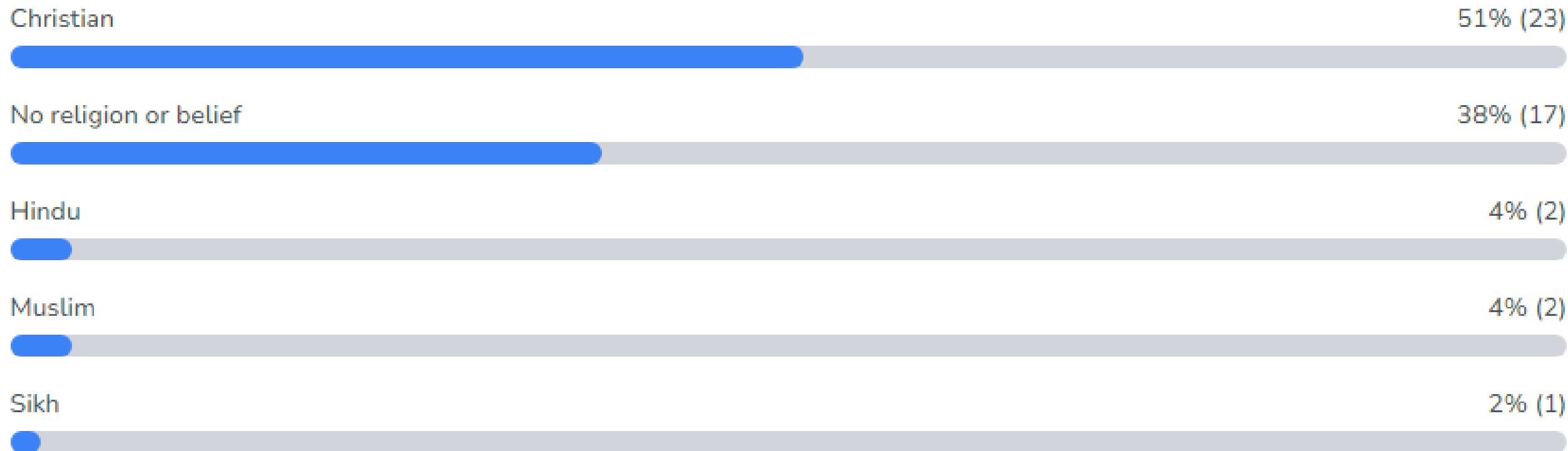

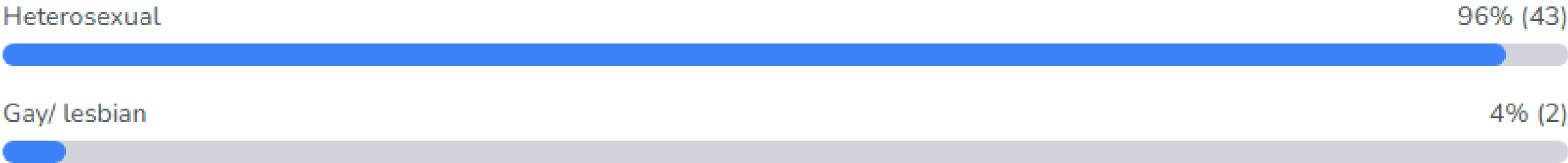

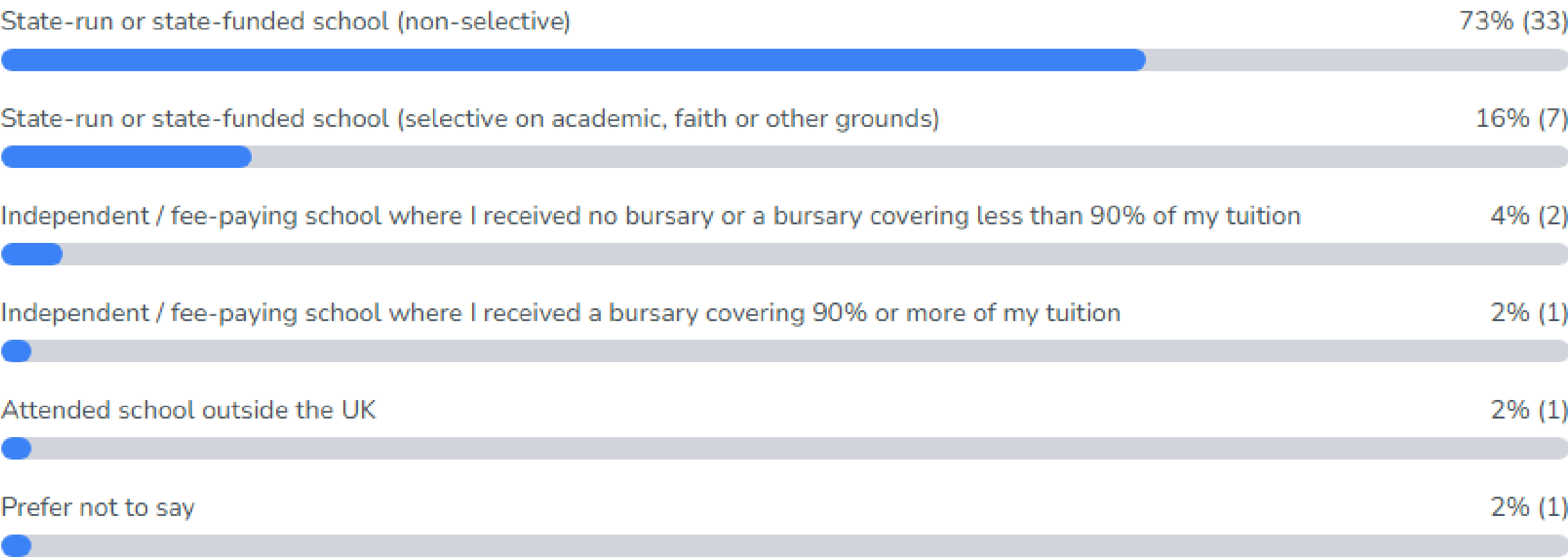

Which type of school did you attend for the most time between the ages 11 and 16?

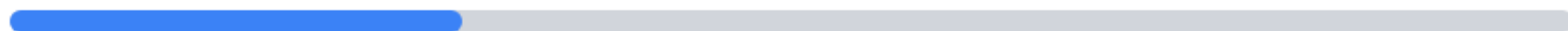


Did either of your parents attend university and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?

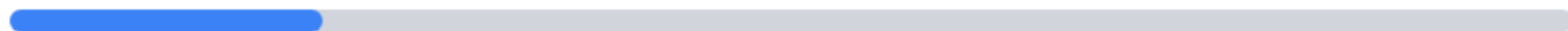


## What was the occupation of your main household earner when you were about 14?

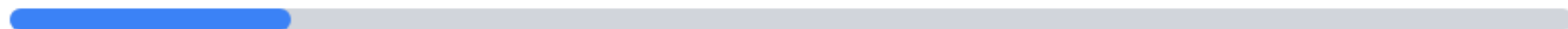

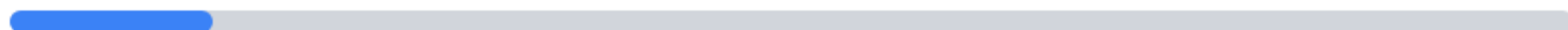
Technical and craft occupations such as: motor mechanic, plumber, printer, electrician, gardener, train driver 20% (9)



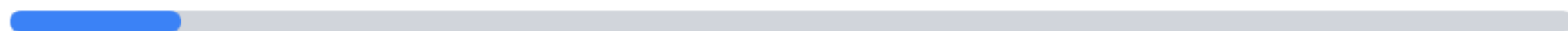

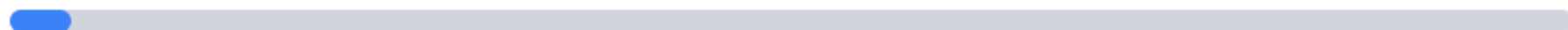

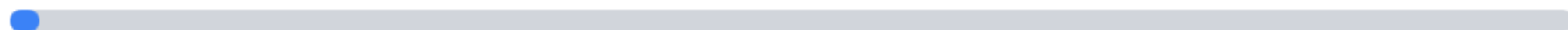

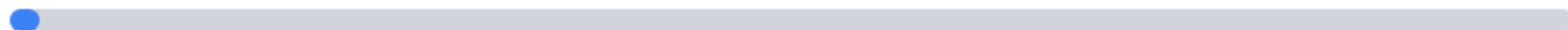
Long term unemployed (claimed Jobseeker's Allowance or earlier unemployment benefit for more than a year) 4% (2)
